› Throughout an implementation program for watershed protection, our **natural resources** and **public relations** work for the State of California involved building partnerships with local communities by providing them with extensive training, reference materials, and technical knowledge to increase their capacity to accurately assess and effectively manage critical watersheds at a local level.

› In a **sustainability** and **natural resources** project for the Air Force, we conducted wet-season hydrological monitoring, dry-season protocol-level surveys, geographic information systems (GIS) mapping, pre-construction site visits, and training, which achieved the compliance our client required to meet operational needs while protecting natural habitat for threatened and endangered species.

› During a **cultural resources** and **public relations** project for the Army, we combined our historic preservation and technology expertise to produce an interactive, Web-based, three-dimensional re-creation of a historic site, helping our client to cost-effectively achieve compliance, provide unprecedented public access to a cultural heritage resource, and earn accolades from the state historic preservation office.
